0900	Minibus Depart GILLINGHAM (Orchard Park Garden Centre - SP8 5JG) (for those from north of the Guild) - Free parking (and access to toilets) by kind permission of Richard Cumming. <i>If oversubscribed, priority on the minibus will be given to people coming from outside East Dorset branch</i>
0950	Minibus Pick up at BERE REGIS (Turberville Road Car Park – BH20 7HA) (for those joining from West Dorset/ Dorchester/ East Dorset)
1030 - 1130	WORTH MATRAVERS (6 bells – tenor 6 cwt)
1150	Drop off in Corfe Castle (minibus to park at Norden Car Park (BH20 5DW))
1200 - 1300	CORFE CASTLE (6 bells – tenor 11 cwt)
1300 - 1350	Free time in Corfe Castle and Break for LUNCH - you are advised to bring a packed lunch as Corfe 'eateries' will be busy. (Lunch can be taken at the picnic tables in the yard and/ or picnic area at Corfe Station) – if you want fish and chips – plenty of outlets in Swanage
1350 - 1425	Arrive at Corfe Castle Station (1350) in time to catch 1402 service on Swanage Railway to SWANAGE (arrive 1424)
	
1425 -1600	SWANAGE (Beach time - lifeguard patrolled and 'Blue Flag – or other 'free time' activities in town)
1600 - 1700	SWANAGE (8 bells – tenor 22 cwt)
1710 - 1800	Arrive at Swanage Station (1710) – catch 1720 service on Swanage Railway to arrive at Norden station (arrive 1745). Fifteen minutes break – leave Norden (1800)
1820 - 1920	WOOL (6 bells – tenor 11 cwt)
1935	Drop off at BERE REGIS
2020	Drop off at GILLINGHAM

There will be no charge for the day but a voluntary donation for each young ringer and adult would be most welcome (to go towards donations to towers, minibus hire and railway fares).
